COVID-19 and General Health Plan

Transportation

Arrowhead School District runs one route from its most southern bus stop (Dry Creek) to its most northern (Trail Creek/Green Boxes). The route services roughly 20-30 students daily. This includes any extracurricular activities that require transportation.

Stage 1 (school is in session, with remote learning for those not comfortable or able to return).

- **Masks will be required on all route buses.**
- Students will load the bus back to front and unload front to back to reduce contact.
- Routine cleaning of bus

Facilities

The recommended custodial staff size based on building size for Arrowhead School District is 1 FTE custodians. The custodial staff has been able to perform a deep clean using the closure time in the spring to get a head start on regular summer cleaning.

- Attention toward high touch areas disinfected daily (i.e. doorknobs, handrails...)

When students are sick

If student is showing signs of illness they will be directed to parent or nurse's room until parent can be reached. If parents are not able to be reached or pick up the child within an hour, emergency contacts will be called. It is recommended if a student is ill or showing signs of illness for the protection of staff and students all involved will wear a mask. If testing staff is available and parent consent is signed rapid testing may be administered.

If a student or staff member tests positive for COVID19 recommendations on how to proceed will come from the City/Park County Health Department. Please notify the school if your child tests positive.

Arrowhead school administration will be transparent and notify all families upon knowledge of a positive test; however, students will not be identified and the school will follow FERPA guidelines. The school will then rely on guidance from the health department regarding tracing and school closure.

Instruction

Teachers have developed remote learning plans identifying platforms they will use in the event it is needed with Administrative approval. This could include paper packets, remote learning, or a combination.

- The multipurpose room, used for Art and Music will be disinfected between each cohort.
- Also, the computer lab will have to have limited enrollment and/or spillover may have to use the library. Classrooms will be encouraged to use one:one Chromebooks in the classroom.

Classroom Guidelines

To provide the best possible education while protecting students and staff from Covid-19, or other communicable illness the following guidelines will be in place for Arrowhead School classrooms.

- Classrooms will use individual desks where practical.
- Desks will be spaced as far apart as possible.
- Social distancing and masks will be utilized as required by the CDC, local, state or federal guidelines.
- Regular hand-washing routines will be established and hand sanitizer available in the classrooms.
- Proper hygiene will be taught as part of SEB curriculum at the start of school in grades K-8
- Students will be encouraged to clean desks/surfaces regularly throughout the day.

Lunchroom Guidelines

- Students will eat with their cohort and tables will be disinfected between cohorts or students will eat at their desks.
- The salad bar will be served to students.
- Condiments will be prepackaged/individual servings

Recess

Recess will be monitored to keep students moving and active and to avoid students grouping without following physical distancing guidelines. Students will attend recess with their cohorts when possible.

PE- Will follow Park County Health guidance given for open gyms.

PEAK (Afterschool Program)

- Social distancing and masks will be utilized as required by the CDC, local, state or federal guidelines.
- Handwashing upon start
- Outdoors as much as possible.
- Hand sanitizing when leaving

Field Trips

Outings will be carefully considered by staff, administration, and the School Board Chair.

Substitute teachers

Substitute teachers will be briefed on school protocols prior to entering the classroom.

Cleaning

Custodial Staff will clean the school daily.

Update contact info

It is critical for families to make sure the school has their most recent contact information, as well as a valid emergency contact. In the event of illness, the school will be contacting emergency contacts if primary contact cannot be reached. Also, the school will send communications through Infinite Campus to reach all families promptly.
