Parent/Guardian & Student Expectations

Transporting students to school and back home is a big responsibility. Riding the bus is a student privilege that needs to be taken seriously. Student safety is the priority. Let's make this a great year on the bus!

Parents/Guardians

- 1. Read this information carefully & review w/ your child the expectations that apply to them, sign and return.
- 2. Send a written note in the morning to your child's teacher if you need to make transportation changes for the day.
- 3. School voicemail will be checked at 8:00 a.m., at noon, and at 3:00 p.m. Please plan accordingly.
- 4. Arrive at the bus stop at least five (5) minutes early for both drop off & pick-up as arrival times can vary. Kindergarten through second grade parents/guardians must pick the child up <u>at the door of the bus</u> unless the student is leaving the bus with an older sibling.
- 5. Students not picked-up at the bus stop will be returned to school at the end of the bus route.
- 6. Everyone wants your child to be safe. Should a situation occur when things don't go as planned, please remain calm and respectful of the school employees that are trying to assist you. Rude and threatening behavior will not be tolerated.
- 7. Please park on the same side of the road as the bus to avoid children having to cross the roadway.

Students

- 1. Wait until the bus comes to a complete stop and the red lights are flashing before crossing a road or approaching a bus. NEVER CHASE AFTER A MOVING BUS.
- 2. Kindergarten through second grade students must be with an adult when crossing roads.
- 3. Cross in <u>front</u> of the bus when getting on and off. Do not touch the arm that comes out in front of the bus.
- 4. While riding the bus, sit facing forward. Sit flat on your bottom. Keep hands, feet, & objects to yourself and out of the aisle. Backpacks are to be kept on student laps or under the seat in front of them.
- 5. No heads, hands, arms, or objects are to be placed out of the windows at any time.
- 6. No changing of seats or standing up while the bus is moving.
- 7. Voice levels should be a Level 1 (partner talk) which means speaking quietly.
- 8. All students will have permission to utilize phones during bus rides to and from school or school sponsored events. Students will understand that permission to utilize phones will be with the expectations of being responsible for their devices, respectful to all students and staff members and utilizing them in safe and appropriate ways. Any irresponsible or inappropriate uses of cell phones, including cyberbullying will be addressed by the administration.
- 9. Eating or drinking on the bus is with permission of the adult in charge. Trash should be disposed of appropriately.
- 10. Follow directions; be respectful and courteous to the driver.
- 11. To provide a safe environment buses are equipped with both video and audio surveillance. Tapes are monitored.
