Byron Kassing/ safety program, the discussion was is there a safety program currently?
A. Aleece Decker/ she believes there maybe a starting template that was generated by previous principal Jillian lyerson.

- B. Discussion continued as to the desire of the committee to begin investigation as to the state of this possible outline. Also to begin discussion and planning to prepare draft safety program utilizing the input of required standards along with school Administration and Superintendent.
- 2. Aleece Decker/ maintenance needed to repair vapor barrier poly on the ceiling of the attic crawl space above the furnaces.

Agenda items:

A. Leak in main office.

Committee recommends further in wall investigation of the leak. Appears there is Plumbing the wall that may possibly be leaking.

B. Old school building structural roof damage.

Committee recommends investigation into the damage and perform maintenance/ Repair needed.

- b. An access point to that portion of the old school may or may not be available If not an access point would need to be made.
- C. Floor scrubber machine life span /replacement cost

Aleece Decker, current machine has been repaired and is non reparable moving forward. Machine continued lifespan is unknown. If break down occurs without replacement rhetorical stop gap would be hand mopping daily and use of Kyle's machine once weekly. Replacement cost between \$4000-\$5200 depending on which machine is chosen. The cheaper of the two appears to best match the current machine in use.

c. Given the fact the gym floor is used as a cafeteria the need to provide sanitary and clean surface after food service the committee recommends a replacement machine.
