

WALK TO READ AND WALK TO MATH - UPPER GRADES

Our 4th - 8th grade students will be starting a Walk to Read and Walk to Math instructional model on Tuesday, March 5th. This model emphasizes meeting students where they are in Reading and Math.

What does this mean? This model is a targeted and leveled approach that will provide foundational skills for our 4th-8th grade students in need, provide on level instruction for those at grade level, and extend learning for those needing enrichment. This approach has been shown to provide high yield lessons that meet the needs of all students in the group/class, provide more repetition to master concepts, and allows for more streamlined progress monitoring and assessment.

Students in Walk to Read and Walk to Math may join another class or work in a small group. Our Walk to Read segment will be daily from 8:15 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. and our Walk to Math will be from 10:15 - 11:30 a.m.

LIBRARY TO FUTURE KITCHEN PROJECT

At the February Board Meeting, the Arrowhead Board of Trustees moved to work towards our kitchen expansion project by completing the first, essential step of building a wall in the existing library, which will serve as the eventual boundary of a re-imagined kitchen. Initially this newly created space can also function as essential storage space for both food supplies and physical education equipment which currently occupy one of our classrooms. Freeing up a classroom is just one of the many amazing benefits of making forward progress on Arrowhead's kitchen expansion project.

The collaborative efforts of our kitchen committee, which includes our hard working food services director Glenda Roberts, has helped bring to life a vision which will allow for more efficient integration of our efforts to serve students more local products.
